

Week 6 – We Made Sex God

Example Questions

We want your group to generate questions that are relevant to your group. To tackle questions and issues that are sources of confusion and opportunities for growth for *your* students.

Confusion: Why does our sexuality matter so much? Aren't the physical and the spiritual completely different, unconnected?

Thinking: 1 Corinthians 6 tells us that our bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit. God chooses to dwell within us—to be present even in our physical bodies—what can this teach us about the God we serve?

Being: How can dating a non-believer affect me? How does it affect my identity or my mission? How can I avoid non-Christian relationships without hurting my witness to that person?

Doing: How can we as a core group spur one another on and lift one another out of any sexual sin any of us might be bogged down in? How can we hold one another accountable and challenge one another toward a more holy view of sexuality?

Going: How can we, as the forgiven Church, serve those who follow the sexual culture of this world? How can we serve and love those outside the Church? What about those who are inside the Church and are still struggling with sexual sin?
